  - London Borough of Camden lead authority
  - Funded by Cabinet Office (2001/2002)
  - -Freely adoptable by local authorities
  - Focused on web standards
- Local Authority Websites Project
  - National Projects Programme



#### The APLAWS+ CMS

- Based on Red Hat's CMS & Portal Server
- Project hosted on SourceForge.Net
- Zero License Fee (Open source)
- Standards integration
  - Interoperability: e-GIF
  - Metadata: e-GMS, Dublin Core
  - Accessibility: WAI AA
  - Taxonomies: LGCL, LGSL, IPSV



#### Current Status

- IPR handed over to Camden, August 2005
- 30+ UK local authorities users
  - Internet, Intranet, schools and other sites
- 10+ international users
  - UNDP, Malaysian university, Chinese metrological bureau, Australian local authority & now South Africa
- 6+ local APLAWS+ suppliers
- Recommended by European e-Government Good Practice Framework (GPF)



#### The Application

- Quick start guide & Core documentation
- Adheres to <u>open standards</u>
- Structured development
  - E.g. use of a templating engine
- Use other open source software
- Explicitly stated development process
- Establish a release framework
- A single official release
- Code submission criteria
- A single public code repository
- Published release schedule




## User Community

#### Open Source License

- Originally released under GNU Public License (GPL)
- Also required copyright assignment for dual licensing
- Later released under Lesser GNU Public License (LGPL)
- Added interest from suppliers to integrate and resell APLAWS+



#### The Websites

- Complete resource for all things APLAWS+
  - Facilitate active communications & collaboration
  - Promote APLAWS+ (Demo instance)
- Currently in the process of upgrading from a LAMP based site to an APLAWS+ site
- Need a mascot



#### Joint Procurement

- Investigated three "partnership vehicles"
  - Contractual vehicles
  - Administrative vehicles
  - Joint venture vehicles
- Another option is the subscription model
